II. KYORUGI/SPARRING SCOPE OF PARTICIPATION

- a. This event shall be open to all PILIPINAS TAEKWONDO Inc. (PTI) affiliated schools/clubs/gyms nationwide and other invited teams
- b. Participants must represent their school, club or gym.
- c. Correct AGE is calculated as follows: the year of the Championship, 2026 minus your birth year no matter which month you were born, i.e. $2026 - 2015 = 11$ years old.
- d. Age requirements:

Grade School Division	11 Years Old & Below
Cadet Division	12 - 14 yrs Old
Junior Division	15 –17 Years Old
Senior Division	18 Years Old & Above

- e. We shall apply the NOVICE and ADVANCE Format of Competition in Children, Cadet and Juniors Division. The Seniors Division will Open Format.
- f. There will be no more registration during competition proper. Only verified & finalized Master List will be entertained. This is to ensure smooth running of the tournament.
- g. “NO INTERRUPTION AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE. All participants, coaches, parents, and organizers are tasked at helping out with regards to cleanliness and orderliness of the venue.
- h. Furthermore, all parties are expected to have fun and enjoy their participation. All requirements should be submitted and all payments settled. Please bring your own TEAM BANNER OR STREAMER for the opening ceremony.



III. JUDO DIVISION AND CATEGORIES (ALL MEDALS)

a. Grade School Boys & Girls Division (Novice & Advance).

Contestants who are 11 Years old & under will have their height measured as follows:

IV. KYORUGI METHOD OF COMPETITION & SPECIAL PROVISIONS

- a. The competition will be single-elimination (Knock-out System).
- b. All matches from Eliminations to Finals will be Best of (3) Three rounds with 1 minute and 30 seconds per round and with 30 seconds rest in between rounds. Each Division is divided into 2 Categories:

NOVICE : Yellow, Orange, Green and Blue Belters (8th Gup to 5th Gup)

ADVANCE: Purple, Brown, Red, Red w/ Black stripes and Black Belters
(4th Gup to 1st Poom/Dan)

- c. Novice Division Guidelines:

It is the spirit of the Novice Division to provide an opportunity for beginners to compete with other players with the same skill level. It is therefore against the spirit of this provision to have players who have stayed long in Yellow Belt or Blue Belt; or who have developed skills equivalent to Red Belt or higher to participate in the Novice Division. Instructors and coaches are therefore reminded to use their discretion in fielding players in the Novice Division.

➤ The following should compete in the advanced division:

- Players who have developed advanced skills (power, speed and technique).
- Players who have had prior martial arts training before joining Taekwondo.
- Members of school varsity teams, school or LGU selections.

- d. Sanctions:

- Players found to have violated this provision shall be suspended from participating in any Pilipinas Taekwondo organized competitions for one (1) year.
- The instructor, along with all the chapters he handles, will likewise be suspended from participation in PTI competitions and will be barred from taking the promotion test for a minimum of one (1) year or shall pay a fine of Php 10,000.
- The instructor shall also issue a letter of explanation and apology addressed to the PTI Council.



V. INDIVIDUAL STANDARD, PAIR & TEAM POOMSAE EVENT (WORLD CLASS & ALL MEDALS)

- a. Colored belt contestants shall perform ONLY (1) ONE of the following prescribed poomsae for their belt level.
- b. Blackbelt contestants shall perform (2) TWO prescribed poomsae for their category. The average score of both performances will be the final score.
- c. PAIR STANDARD POOMSAE
 - For Blackbelt Division, the oldest player age will be the basis for the prescribed poomsae.
 - **No Restrictions on Gender (All Male/Female or Mix)**
- d. TEAM STANDARD POOMSAE
 - For Blackbelt Division, the oldest player age will be the basis for the prescribed poomsae.
 - Maximum of (3) per team
 - **No Restrictions on Gender (All Male/Female or Mix)**
- e. Belt Level and Required Form for Individual, Pair and Team Standard.

f. Division and Age requirements

f.1 Correct AGE is calculated as follows: the year of the Championship, 2025 minus your birth year no matter which month you were born, i.e. $2025 - 2015 = 10$ years old.

Group 1 Boys & Girls	7-9 years old (GS)
Group 2 Boys & Girls	10-13 years old (Cadet)
Group 3 Male & Female	14-17 years old (Jr)
Group 4 Male & Female	18 years old and above (Sr)
Instructors Division	by arrangement (Sr)

VI. PROTESTS, ARBITRATION AND PENALTIES

- a. All protests regarding match results should be done in writing and submitted to the Chief of Referees within 10 minutes after the match in question.
- b. A protest fee of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) shall be paid, in case the protest submitted rules in favor of the aggrieved party the fee will be refunded. However, the said fee will not be refunded if the ruling goes against the aggrieved party.
- c. All players will be penalized for the following offense:
 - ❖ Loitering around the competition area.
 - ❖ If any member of their team causes any form of disruption of the match in question and the tournament in general.
 - ❖ **SITTING ON THE FLOOR AND SETTING UP CHAIRS AND MATS OUTSIDE THE SPECTATORS AREA ARE STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED.**
- d. All players should be at their respective inspection area. For the smoother running of the tournament, players will be given 3 chances to be called to report to their inspection area with 5 min intervals after which, when they fail to show up, they will be defaulted automatically. It is the responsibility of the player to be aware of their fight diagram and fight number. After winning their fight, they should proceed to their inspection area to rest and wait for their next match.



- e. In case where the players are not present during the tournament, the coaches are instructed to report to their respective court managers and inform them that this particular player has backed out or will not be able to play. So that it will be duly noted and recorded and the corresponding win will be awarded to the opposing player. This will be done to make sure that fights will be easier to manage.
- f. Overall Championship trophies shall be determined by the total number of medals won starting with the most number of gold medals won followed by the number of silver and bronze medals in official categories. Medals won in the **All Poomsae categories shall be given (1) ONE COUNT WEIGHT** and Medals in Team Events will only be given **(1) ONE COUNT WEIGHT per Team**.
- g. The winners in the Mixed and Team poomsae will not be included In determining the Division Champion but there medals will be included in the computation in the OVER ALL CHAMPION.

VII. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- a. Competition Codes of Conduct: The PTI Competition Codes of Conduct shall be strictly enforced
- b. In cases where there are too few participants in a certain category, the Tournament Chairman may merge categories and divisions. However, If there is still no opponent, the player will be awarded Gold and will be included in the Overall Medal Tally.
- c. Equipment: WT GRANDSLAM PSS will be provided by the organizers and All Kyorugi (Novice & Advance) **Players are required to bring their own WT GRANDSLAM OR WAYCHAMP SENSING SOCKS**. Only the brands recognized by the PILIPINAS TAEKWONDO and WT shall be used during the tournament.
- d. All players should be in **complete dobuk (WHITE COLOR ONLY)** and wear their respective belts.
- e. No Groin Guards No Play and a warning will be charged against players entering the playing area without Hand Gloves.
- f. Wearing of MOUTHPIECE will be required for children participating in Group 3 Category & above (136cm & above).
- g. Standing provisions regarding arbitration and penalties shall apply.
- h. All coaches are advised to inform the organizing committee of any discrepancies in the fight diagram or misplacements of their players so that corresponding adjustments will be made.
- i. All coaches are required to wear Proper Attire. No slippers, Caps, Sleeveless shirts.
- j. All Contingents are encouraged to be available at the time set to enable us to start as soon as possible.
